Request:

The details of the policy - regarding oncology treatment for inpatients in your Trust's hospital.

- a. if a patient residing in one of the trust's hospitals was diagnosed or had previously been diagnosed with cancer, would they be able to receive treatment when they were an inpatient.
- b. If not, does the Trust have a policy of patients receiving treatment for cancer only when they are an outpatient and does this depend on which kind of treatment they receive?
- c. In addition, could you please confirm the average time it takes from the decision that a patient is medically fit to be discharged until they are discharged.
